Performance Note:

Split is a scene for female voice and electronics. Text used in composition is a poem by Edgar Allan Poe called "Dream within a dream".

An accidental refers only to note it preceeds.

The score has no strict barline indications. The music material should be performed according to a general metronomic tempo indication as precisely as it is possible. The fermata can be interpreted with more space, wherever introduced in the score. The dashed slurs are introduced in the part to easily read the phrasing and narration of music.

There is no click track, but the performer can trigger the cues to start sound files for precised execution. Live processing of the voice, as well as the system synchronization for the sound files, is controlled by the sound artist through Max MSP patch.

Duration of the piece should take around 9 minutes.


A voice part is written on three different kinds of stave notation:


