## Furtive Variations

*for vertixe sonora*

The music piece "Furtive Variations" is composed of several sound fragments that originate from the initial piano bars at the beginning of the work. The piano starts with a sound morphology in a lower register, which evolves throughout the composition. The title "variations" may not be entirely precise, as these fragments are improvised creations developed at the piano based on the original sound idea. They have been written and revised to perfection.

These musical fragments capture fleeting and transitory emotions. They evoke a range of feelings from indignation to wonder, and they move the heart in profound ways. They convey a sense of intimacy and uncertainty that reflects the essence of our everyday lives.
